As Wellingborough School is a registered charity, under the current UK tax law any legacy left to the School is exempt of Inheritance Tax and such gifts are deducted from the value of the estate before any liability to IHT is calculated.

The Graham Garrett Society

We have established the Graham Garrett Society in honour of the former Headmaster (1973-1993) who is considered by many to be the father of modern Wellingborough School.



All those who have informed the School of their intention to leave a legacy are invited to become members. The Society holds an annual meeting at the School for all members, their spouses and partners which includes a lunch hosted by the Headmaster.
