Speaking

- Practise with the a French / Spanish native speaker
- Concentrate on the pronunciation by recording yourself
- Visit the target speaking country
- Practise with another student
- Use the target language as much as you can in class
- Read aloud to improve your pronunciation

Reading

- Read articles from newspapers in French / Spanish on the Internet
- Read a book in the target language
- Build your vocabulary from reading independently and revise regularly
- Read the texts you have studied in class
- Use the resources in the library and the MFL Department

Listening

- Listen to the radio and watch TV programmes or DVDs in the target language
- Use the tape scripts of all the listening exercises we do in class
- Use Authentic
- Complete as many past papers as you can before your examination

Writing

- Practise writing without any reference materials
- Write essays you have done in class and try to improve them in the time limit
- Before you submit an essay, check for careless mistakes such as verb endings, gender etc.
- Stick to the structures you know
- Complete extra pieces of writing and ask your teacher to check them
