



Vehicle and Pedestrian Arrangements

The School aims to segregate pedestrians and vehicles wherever possible, although the Victorian origins of the site do not make this easy. The following arrangements are in place:

Visitors/parents in vehicles

- The School operates a one way system with entrance and exit located on Irthlingborough Road.
- The site speed limit is 10 m.p.h.
- The designated parking areas are the main car park and (for visiting the Preparatory School) spaces in front of the Prep School's visitors' entrance. Other spaces on either drive are for staff use only.
- Minibuses should be parked in the designated spaces in the 'North Quad' – immediately to the right on entering the site.
- To maintain the free flow of traffic but more importantly good visibility, pupils should not be dropped off by Garne's, Weymouth, Marsh or Nevill houses, or by the dining hall unless Pre-Prep pupils attending the breakfast club.
- The main car park is segregated into a number of bays. There are three designated for parents' staff and visitors and one specifically for 6th form. This is to ensure that drivers from one group do not block those from the other in.
- Although not line painted because of the surface, the vertical fence posts designate a parking space and are set to the width of a space which would be painted on a tarmac surface. To ensure maximum efficiency, please always park between the posts.
- Car park marshals are in place at morning and afternoon peak times. Please help them to help you by following their instructions.
- The areas immediately in front of the Pre-Prep and the astro turf are designated parking areas for Pre-Prep staff only, arranged to allow safe passage of Pre-Prep pupils.
- The drop off zone is just that: for dropping off or picking up pupils. If you are stopping long enough to switch off your engine, please use a parking space – not the drop off zone.
- Please do not park in Castle Street, Isebrook hospital grounds or The Cloisters – our resident neighbours have the entitlement for their vehicles and we wish to maintain good relations.
- Please do not stop on Irthlingborough Road between the entrance and exit drives. Aside from inhibiting visibility, this is the only place that coaches can stop.
- At all times, parents should ensure their children are under their secure control in the car park and adjoining areas.

Visitors/parents/pupils as pedestrians

- There is a designated pedestrian entrance, located between the exit and entrance drives – please use it and encourage your children to do so.
- Please walk on designated paths and cross drives on designated crossings.
- The designated path from the pedestrian entrance runs between Garne's and the tennis courts and then adjacent to the drive (left hand side moving down the site).
- The designated path to the Pre-Prep runs through the car park, between 6th form and parent/staff visitor areas as an extension of the path adjacent to the main drive, and then along the southern perimeter of the car park, crossing the field access and continuing north of the astro turf, emerging close to the Pre-Prep visitors entrance.



- The designated route from the car park/sports fields towards the exit is via the sports hall steps, in front of the Robinson Centre, the pedestrian crossing to the music school, up the footpath and right across the pedestrian crossing to in front of the Prep School, to arrive at the Prep School. For pedestrians wishing to leave the site, turn left after the music school and walk along the path adjacent to the Chapel, taking the first right and the footpath between gardens/tennis court and the Garrett Centre.
- When using the entrances to Platt's and Fryer's houses, the meeting room, study centre or senior hall, be alert to the possibility of service vehicles reversing to the kitchen entrance. The drivers' vision may be restricted and they will not be able to see pedestrians as easily as pedestrians will be able to see them.
