

COVID 19 – Key Controls

As we have moved to Step 4 on the road map the 4 key controls the school will continue to follow are:

- 1. Ensure good hygiene for everyone.
- 2. Maintain appropriate cleaning regimes.
- 3. Keep occupied spaces well ventilated.
- 4. Follow public health advice on testing, self-isolation and managing confirmed cases of COVID 19.

Return to school testing

Staff

• Staff are requested to carry out two lateral flow tests at home prior to the school fully opening, and to test twice weekly thereafter. Results reported on the NHS app.

Pupils

• Senior (Y7 and above) offered two onsite Lateral Flow Device (LFD) tests 3 – 5 days apart prior to returning to school, and then requested to carry out tests twice weekly thereafter. Results reported on the NHS app.

A positive test result must be reported to covid@wellingboroughschool.org.

Face Coverings

 Not advised anywhere onsite, although will be required to be worn when using school transport. However, they should be carried by staff and pupils in Y7 and above in case they are required as a first response in stepping up controls.

The school also has an Outbreak Management Plan (OMP) which it will implement if directed to by Public Health England (PHE).
